

COMMUNIQUE – MEETING NO. 2: 1 - 2 MARCH, 2018

The second meeting of the NT Clinical Senate was held on March 1 and 2, 2018 at Parliament House.

Dr Hugh Heggie, the Chief Health Officer, gave a presentation on the burden of disease covering the uniqueness of the NT, status and trajectories, projection and planning, priorities and the roles and responsibilities of the Senate.

The Commonwealth Chief Medical Officer, Professor Brendan Murphy, presented the overview of his portfolio, discussing major policy and strategy areas of the Commonwealth Government.

The roles and functions of the NTCS Executive Committee were discussed and clarified and expressions of interest from all members were encouraged.

Members worked on the priorities and action plan that will drive the work of the Senate over the next 12 months, including recommendations to the Chief Executive.

The next NT Clinical Senate Meeting will be held on May 31 and June 1, 2018.
