COVID-19 Vaccine Schedule

March 2021

The Northern Territory COVID-19 vaccine program is based on the [COVID-19 vaccine national rollout strategy](#).

COVID-19 vaccines will be made available in phases to priority groups identified by the Australian Government.

Please note the recommendations for dosage and schedule of COVID-19 vaccines:

COVID-19 vaccine brand	Dose	Route	No. of doses	Interval	Pregnancy category*	Indication
COMIRNATY (Pfizer)	0.3ml	IM	2	At least 21 days between first and second dose	B1	For all persons 18 years and over as part of the COVID-19 vaccine national rollout strategy. People should receive two doses of the same vaccine. Mixing of COVID-19 vaccines is not recommended.
ChAdOx1S (AstraZeneca)	0.5ml	IM	2	12 weeks between first and second dose If this interval is not possible, a minimum interval of 4 weeks between doses can be used	B2	There should be an interval of at least 14 days between receiving a dose of COVID-19 vaccine and any other vaccine. *There is limited experience with use of COVID-19 vaccines in pregnant women. Administration should only be considered when the potential benefits outweigh any potential risks for the mother and fetus. See TGA information below.
