	Adolescents	dTpa[#] - Single dose-routinely given at 12 years Catch up unvaccinated adolescents until under 20 years	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
	Pregnant women	dTpa[#] - Single dose from 20 weeks gestation in every pregnancy - can be given earlier in pregnancy if high or medium risk contact	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people (NT funded)	All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children aged 9yrs to less than 10 years	DTPa/dTpa[#] - Additional age-appropriate dose if more than 5 years since last dose Always ensure catch up under the NIP is complete	Infanrix® or Tripacel® Boostrix® - for use during outbreak if Tripacel® or Infanrix® are not available	
	All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 10 years and over	dTpa[#] - Additional dose if more than 5 years since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
Frontline Workers (NT funded)	Frontline workers See vaccine eligibility NT.GOV.AU	dTpa[#] - Additional dose if more than 5 years since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
Contacts as per the diphtheria management risk matrix (NT funded)	High risk contacts	DTPa/dTpa[#] - Additional age-appropriate dose if more than 12 months since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®	Under 10 years old - give Tripacel®/Infanrix® (DTPa) 10-year-olds and over - give Boostrix® or Adacel® (dTpa)
	Medium risk contacts	DTPa/dTpa[#] - Additional age-appropriate dose if more than 12 months since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
	Low risk contacts	DTPa/dTpa[#] - Additional age-appropriate dose if more than 5 years since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®	
Cases (NT funded)	Identified cases	DTPa/dTpa[#] - Additional age-appropriate dose once clinically well OR 4 weeks after Diphtheria Antitoxin (DAT) administration	Boostrix® or Adacel®	<i>Always ensure catch up under the NIP is complete</i>
Non-Aboriginal adults (NT funded)	Non-Aboriginal adults not in the groups above	dTpa[#] - Additional dose if more than 10 years since last dose	Boostrix® or Adacel®
