The vaccine is free in the Northern Territory from January 2025, to protect those most at risk:

- Adolescents ages 14-19
- Infants, aged 6 weeks to 2 years

Meningococcal disease invades the body from the nose or throat through close prolonged contact and can occur rapidly.

Most people with meningococcal infection fully recover but some people can develop long-term health complications.

It is fatal in 5-10% of cases.

The vaccine can be safely administered with other scheduled immunisations.

It is important that you return your consent form to your school.

The vaccine is also available from GPs, pharmacies, community care centres and remote health services.


