## COVID-19 Directions (No. 34) 2020 Amendment to COVID-19 Directions No. 33

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer, under section 52 of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, consider it necessary, appropriate or desirable to take action to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory, declared by instrument entitled "Declaration of Public Health Emergency", dated 18 March 2020 (the *public health emergency declaration*), by amending direction 8 of my COVID-19 Directions (No. 33) 2020 to omit the words "the revoked Directions" and inserting instead "my COVID-19 Directions (No. 28) 2020".

## Notes for COVID-19 Directions

- 1 Section 56 of the Act provides for an offence for failing to comply with a direction given by me under section 52 of the Act.
- 2 The maximum penalty for this offence is 400 penalty units.
- 3 A person is not guilty of this offence if the person has a reasonable excuse.
