COVID-19 Directions (No. 36) 2022: Amendment to COVID-19 Directions (No. 33) 2022

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer, under section 52 of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, consider it necessary, appropriate or desirable to take action to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory, declared by instrument entitled "Declaration of Public Health Emergency" dated 18 March 2020, by making the following directions:

- 1 These Directions take effect at the time they are made.
- 2 These Directions amend my COVID-19 Directions (No. 33) 2022, as amended by my COVID-19 Directions (No. 34) 2022.
- 3 Direction 6 is amended by inserting the following after direction 6(d):
 - (da) a person exiting the area due to an emergency; or
 - (db) a person exiting the area to escape a risk of harm, including harm relating to family violence; or
 - (dc) a person who entered the area by motor vehicle, public transport or bicycle for the purpose of travelling to a part of the Territory that is outside the area and who:
 - (i) travels directly out of the area in a motor vehicle or on public transport or a bicycle; and
 - (ii) if travelling by vehicle remains in the vehicle while in the area and only leaves the vehicle to refuel the vehicle; and
 - (iii) if travelling on public transport or a bicycle remains on the public transport or bicycle while in the area; or
- 4 Schedule 2, clause 4(1), is amended by omitting the words "the locality of Milingimbi" and inserting instead "Milingimbi Island".
