## COVID-19 Directions (No. 60) 2022: Amendment of COVID-19 Directions (No. 52) 2022

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer, under section 52 of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, consider it necessary, appropriate or desirable to take action to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory, declared by instrument entitled "Declaration of Public Health Emergency" dated 18 March 2020, by making the following directions:

- 1 These Directions take effect when they are made.
- 2 These Directions amend COVID-19 Directions (No. 52) 2022.
- 3 The definition *exempt* in direction 2 is amended by:
  - (a) omitting "third" from paragraph (c); and
  - (b) omitting "second" from paragraph (c)(i)(B); and
  - (c) omitting "; or" from the end of paragraph (c)(ii) and inserting a full stop; and
  - (d) omitting paragraph (d).
- 4 Direction 7(a) is omitted and the following inserting instead:
  - (a) the worker has received 3 doses (in any combination) of approved COVID-19 vaccines or recognised COVID-19 vaccines; or
  - (ab) the worker has received:
    - (i) 1 dose of a COVID-19 vaccine approved as a single dose vaccine by the Therapeutic Goods Administration, Commonwealth Department of Health; and

- (ii) a second dose of an approved COVID-19 vaccine or a recognised COVID-19 vaccine; or
- 5 Direction 8 is amended by omitting example 1 and inserting the following:
  - 1 A vaccination certificate showing the worker has received the number of doses required for the applicable vaccine.
