## COVID-19 Directions (No. 58) 2022: Amendment of COVID-19 Directions (No. 141) 2021

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer, under section 52 of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, consider it necessary, appropriate or desirable to take action to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory, declared by instrument entitled "Declaration of Public Health Emergency" dated 18 March 2020, by making the following directions:

- 1 These Directions take effect when they are made.
- These Directions amend COVID-19 Directions (No. 141) 2021.
- 3 Direction 4(a) is amended by omitting "14" and inserting "7".
- 4 The following is added after direction 5:
  - 5A The proprietor of the aged care facility must:
    - (a) keep a record of the information provided under direction 5(b);and
    - (b) secure the record against access by any person for any purpose other than contact tracing; and
    - (c) not disclose the record except to an authorised officer when requested for contact tracing purposes.
- 5 Direction 9 and Parts 3 and 5 are revoked.
