- (b) under section 254(1) of the Act, approve each Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in Schedule A, and
- (c) under section 254(3) of the Act, state that each Schedule Substance Treatment Protocol specified in Schedule A remains in effect for a period of 2 years on and from the date of this Notice.
