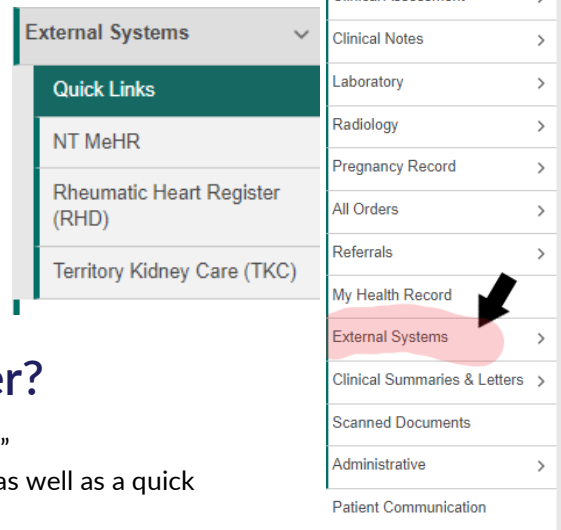


How to find the RHD register and what information is on there

This fact sheet is aimed to assist health care professionals in the NT Hospital systems with finding the NT RHD Register for their patient and gives a brief overview of what information can be found on the NT RHD register.

ACACIA

1. In the patient record click on the “external Systems” tab on the left hand side
2. Then, Click on “Rheumatic Heart Register (RHD)”



What information is on the Register?

You will be taken straight to the patients “Contact Information” tab where it will give you the patients identifying information, as well as a quick overview of their ARF/RHD status such as seen below:

Card letters, Echo's, Discharge Summary's, etc.</p> <p>Prophylaxis: Includes: start & potential cease date, type, LAB's given and locations, Days at risk / Adherence rate & Due date of next LAB.</p> <p>Surgical: overview of valve surgery performed, what type, when and where.</p>

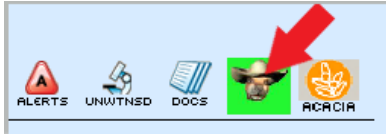
